
ART Polisher: Micro-motor, Straight Nose Cone, and Prophy Head Assembly



Your polisher should come with one of each of the following items:

- ① Micro-motor
- ② Straight nose cone (Straight hand piece)
- 3 Prophy head

Step 1



Hold the straight nose cone in the direction as shown. Locate the locking ring and gently twist the top piece clockwise (away from your body) until you hear it click.

The straight nose cone is now unlocked. Remove the place-holder pin from the tip and discard it.


Step 2




Place the end of the prophy head into the tip of the straight nose cone and push until the two pieces are flush.

The prophy head and straight nose cone should fit together like a puzzle.

Step 3





Close the locking ring on the straight nose cone by turning the top piece counter-clockwise (towards you). This will lock the prophy head securely into place.

Follow this locking/unlocking procedure whenever you are changing prophy heads/attachments.

Step 4



Push the straight nose cone onto the rod of the micro-motor until it snaps into place.

The polisher can now be plugged into the unit, and is ready for use.

[Note: cups and paste are needed for prophy head usage]
